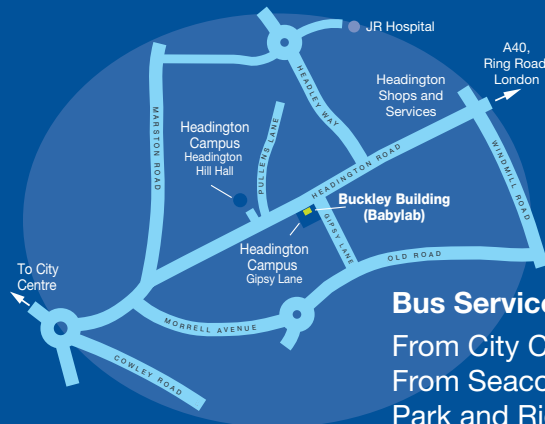


Oxford Brookes Babylab Babytalks

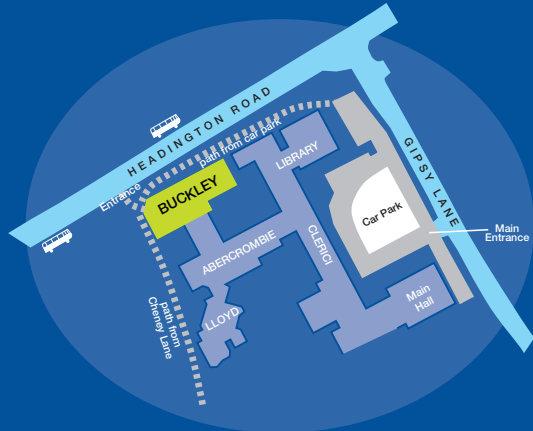
During June 2009 the Oxford Brookes University Babylab will host three informal discussion groups.
